Our post-doctoral fellowship program offers five emphasis areas within the umbrella of Clinical Psychology. These emphasis areas include:

- Primary Care Mental Health Integration – 1 Fellowship Position
- Geropsychology & Integrated Care Psychology – 1 Fellowship Position
- LGBTQ+ Health Care – 1 Fellowship Position
- Inpatient Medical Psychology – 1 Fellowship Position
- Trauma and Posttraumatic Stress Disorder – 1 Fellowship Position

The Psychology Training Program at Hines VA, which dates back to 1947, has enjoyed a long tradition of providing high quality training. The Postdoctoral Fellowship Program at Hines VA first began in 2008. The APA Commission on Accreditation first accredited our program in 2012 and after our most recent site visit in 2019, we were approved for 10 years of continued APA Accreditation.
