Required Learning Experiences

- Orientation – 2 weeks
- Hospital Rotations
 - Operations (Inpatient & Outpatient) – 4 weeks
 - Acute Care – 6 weeks
 - Geriatrics/Long-term Care – 4 weeks
 - Psychiatry – 4 weeks
- Ambulatory Rotations
 - Ambulatory Care – 6 weeks
 - Anticoagulation – 4 weeks
 - Home Based Primary Care – 4 weeks

Required Longitudinal Learning Experiences
