### The Post Baccalaureate Registered Nurse Residency Program (PBRNR)

The PBRNR program is grant funded and supported by the Oklahoma City VA Health Care System and The University of Oklahoma Health Science Center Fran & Earl Ziegler College of Nursing. Post-Baccalaureate Registered Nursing Residents are considered trainees, receiving a stipend and benefits during their year of advanced training. Successful graduates of the program are well-positioned to begin a professional nursing career that Oklahoma City VA Healthcare System (OKC VAHCS).



#### **Program Goals**

- Successfully transition the resident from novice to advanced beginner nurse/competent professional nurse, who provides safe, quality care as defined by Patricia Benner's "Novice to Expert" theory (1984).
- Foster participation in collaborative practice within an interprofessional healthcare team while demonstrating clinical leadership.
- Develop competency in effective decision-making skills related to clinical judgment and performance.
- Encourage the incorporation of research and evidence-based practice in professional nursing.
- Formulate an individual career development plan promoting life-long commitment to professional nursing.

#### **Unique VA Opportunities New Graduate RN**

The Post Baccalaureate Registered Nurse Residency Program (PBRNR) is a highly competitive program seeking Registered Nurses for an intensive twelve-month training program that incorporates a clinical, didactic, and evidence-based curriculum. The focus is on preparing the new graduate to transition into acute care, ambulatory, and outpatient settings.

#### **PBRNR Program Eligibility**

- Graduated from a CCNE or ACEN accredited program with a BSN or MSN with less than one year of experience as an RN
- US Citizen by birth or naturalization
- Minimum grade point average: 3.00
- Possess a current, active, unrestrictive license
- NCLEX scheduled before the end of June

#### **Benefits**

- 12 months paid 100 percent Protected Learning Time with no service obligation
- Paid leave. Up to 26 days earned annual and sick leave as well as 11 paid Federal holidays
- Professional Development
- A Curriculum that provides a variety of learning opportunities, including didactic, webbased learning, and simulation
