VA-STEP – VA Student Trainee Experience Program

(formerly VALOR)

Applications must be received by February 2, 2024

- ☐ Application Weblink: (control click to access)
- Choose an email account to use, and you will receive an email to set up an ID.me account (if you don't have one)
- For ID.me account you will need to input your address, phone number, Social Security number, a selfie (to verify you are who you say you are), and identity documentation (Examples: Drivers license, passport, etc.)
- Choose Nursing and then Facility (Southern Arizona VA Health Care System)
- Once you have and ID.me account you can then you can log back in with your ID.me email and password
- You will have a task in your Active Task List, where you will click START
- When you get to the screen that asks for VA Training Start Date AND Completion date click unknown
- Answer the Essay Questions (ensure good grammar and try to make your responses revolve around Veterans (suggest typing responses in Word and copy and paste)
- After completion, fix any errors (will be identified in red type)
- Sign and submit for final review
- Certify that the information is correct
- Return to dashboard and click "Details"
- Here you will need to add your Transcript, Resume, 2 recommendation letters (dean/academic faculty/employer/manager) and any other documents (such as DD214 for Veterans)
- Lastly click SUBMIT PACKET in the upper right corner of the document

Must anticipate graduation from an accredited BSN program in December 2024 or May 2025
Must be able to commit to working full-time from late May 2024, until early-August 2024 with no vacation
Cumulative GPA 3.0 or greater
If selected, must pass pre-employment physical, Federal background check, and drug test
Must not have service commitment to any other institution after graduation
