## Program Description:

- ◆ The PB-RNR Residency is a 12–Month *Protected Experience*. You will **NOT** be counted as staff and will have a preceptor working with you for the entirety of the program.
- ◆ Clinical Rotations include Med/Surg, ICU, PACU/OR, Surgical Clinics, Primary Care, Dialysis, and ED, among others.
- ◆ You will become competent in various technical (i.e., IV and urinary catheter insertion, wound care, etc. ) and critical thinking skills.
- ◆ You will have opportunities to attend experiences outside the Providence VA, such as a Spinal Cord Injury Orientation and Burn Symposium.

## Upon successful completion of the Residency Program, the RN will :

- ◆ Successfully transition from entry-level beginner nurse to competent, professional nurse who provides safe, quality care.
- ◆ Demonstrate effective decision-making skills related to clinical judgment & performance.
- ◆ Incorporate research & other scientific evidence into practice.
- ◆ Demonstrate clinical leadership at the point of practice.

## Program Benefits:

- ◆ Our goal is for you to want to work at the VA. If you choose not to work at the VA, you will not have any obligation for the experience provided.
- ◆ Residents have been hired into areas such as but not limited to the ICU, ED, Med/Surg, Outpatient Oncology/GI, and Inpatient Psych units.
- ◆ Residents receive Healthcare Benefits, 4hrs of Sick Time and 4hrs of Paid Vacation per bi-weekly pay period. Additionally, residents get 12 Federal paid Holidays off.
- ◆ The VA facility provides ample, free on-site parking.
- ◆ Nurse residents receive a bi-weekly trainee salary. Upon accepting a position post-residency, RNs earn a competitive salary, paid time off, and benefits package.
- ◆ Upon accepting a position post-residency, you *may* be eligible for loan forgiveness through our Education Debt Reduction Program.

## Eligibility Requirements:

- ◆ United States citizen
- ◆ Graduated from a CCNE or NLNAC accredited program with a BSN or MSN applying for a **FIRST RN role, less than one year since graduation.**
- ◆ Minimum grade point *average: 3.00*
- ◆ Current, unrestricted RN license (or NCLEX **taken before July 1, 2024**)
- ◆ Pass pre-employment background investigation

## To Apply:

- ◆ Resume and Cover Letter
- ◆ Personal statement—300 words "The VA Post Baccalaureate RN Residency Program interests me because..."
- ◆ Unofficial transcripts (Official upon request)
- ◆ Three letters of support (upon request): two from Faculty (**one of which must be clinical faculty**) & one professional. All letters of support must be on official letterhead.
