



Puppies Assisting Wounded Servicemembers (PAWS) allows Veterans with PTSD the opportunity to train service dogs for their fellow comrades. WPBVAHCS is leading the way as one of five sites nationwide chosen to participate in the PAWS Pilot. In partnership with Dogs for Life of Vero Beach, Florida, Veterans participate in weekly training for a period of eight weeks, at which time the Veteran graduates from the program and the certified service dog is paired with a fellow Veteran.


