VA MFH Caregivers provide:

- 24-hour care and support
- Personal care
- Personalized, comfortable room
- Home cooked, nutritious meals
- Medication management

Some of the requirements for caregiver include:

- Complete an application, interview and vetting process
- Be at least 18 and financially stable
- Have formal or informal experience in patient care
- Have a suitable home with enough living space
- Be physically able to give care

Medical Foster Home Caregivers are privately compensated by Veterans at an agreed upon rate.
