Lebanon VA Medical Center (VAMC) is located in Pennsylvania Dutch country and has been proudly providing care to Veterans for more than 75 years.

It is one of 170 VA medical centers in the nation with the sole purpose of providing world-class medical care to America's Veterans.

Lebanon VAMC is also proud to be one of the leading teaching hospitals in the area. We have a vibrant affiliation with the Penn State Health Milton S. Hershey Medical Center and other local educational institutions.

The Veteran-focused facility is proud of the fact that one-third of its employees are Veterans. Thank you for your service and allowing us to serve you!

Fast Facts

- In 2023, we served 47,729 Veterans in our 9-county service area, including 8,951 Veterans of the Iraq and Afghanistan wars and 4,071 women Veterans.
- In 2023, we had 2,234 full-time employees, including 758 nursing staff, 222 primary-care providers and specialists, 106 social workers, and 38 psychologists.
- Our annual operating budget is about \$461 million.
- We have 188 patient beds: 49 hospital beds, 76 community living center (nursing home) beds, and 63 beds in our psychosocial residential rehabilitation treatment program.
- In 2023, we had 546,628 outpatient visits and 2,773 hospital admissions. Our doctors performed 2,382 surgeries.
