2008 NCA Outreach Summary

- Participated in 2,800 events; audience of nearly 362,000
- Memorial Day 106 ceremonies at VA national cemeteries reached audiences of 122,000 people
- Veterans Day 49 ceremonies; 27,000 people
- Exhibited at 16 national conventions / conferences
 - National veterans conventions
 - Funeral industry & other professional conferences

You Served...

...You're Eligible

If you served in a branch of the military and were discharged under conditions other than dishonorable you may be eligible for burial in a Department of Veterans Affairs National Cemetery.

No-Cost Burial Benefits Include:

A gravesite in any of VA's national cemeteries with available space

Opening and closing of the grave

A headstone or marker

A burial flag

<u>A Presidential Memorial</u> <u>Certificate (PMC)</u>

Perpetual care of the gravesite



Female veterans married to a veteran are entitled to their own separate grave, headstone or marker, burial flag and PMC.

However, they may choose to be buried in the same gravesite as their spouse.

VA National Cemeteries: A Culture of Service to Veterans and Families





National Cemetery Administration FY 2008 – Memorial Programs




