


How to Create a Desktop Shortcut for Telephone Triage Protocols for Nurses



Here is a simplified option to add a shortcut for Telephone Triage's latest edition.


1. Please save the attached .ico file to your desktop (right click on the attachment); I suggest using the name ttpn.ico.



2. Right-click on a blank area on the desktop and select New and then Shortcut




3. A new dialog box will open requesting the URL for the shortcut






4. The next dialog box requests a name for the shortcut; I suggest TTPN, then click Finish.





You will now have the shortcut on the desktop:



5. If you want to change the shortcut icon to the book cover, please right-click on the shortcut and then select properties and in the next dialog box, click change icon:



6. Once you've clicked Change Icon, select browse, desktop and then the TTPN ico (ttnp.ico) and click ok.



7. Now you have the book cover as your shortcut and simply double click the shortcut to get to the book.



I would recommend that you delete the book cover image that was saved to the desktop in order to avoid any confusion. Please remember that this would be the book image without the arrow...
