

**Bibliography & Reference Cited** (First line of new Page)

(Required Field; 1-Page Limit)

Follow Section 7.4 Format instructions for page formatting

Applications with text that exceeds either the font size or line spacing limits will be **administratively withdrawn** from review.

**This section is required for all submissions.** This section should include all references cited in the [Research Plan](#). The reference should be limited to relevant and current literature; it is important to be concise and to select only those literature references pertinent to the proposed research.

**Applications which exceed the 1-page limitation will not be accepted for review.**

For references with more than 8 authors, you may use “et al” after the 8th author has been listed.

**Applications that do not include full references (i.e., title, authors, etc., as indicated above) will not be accepted for review.**

**Internet website addresses (URLs), either active hyperlinks or plain text, are not allowed in the Bibliography & References Cited section.** An example of how one would cite a web-based resource such as CDC is provided below:

*Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, National Centers for Injury Prevention and Control. Web-based Injury Statistics Query and Reporting System (WISQARS) [online]. (2005) {cited Year Month (abbreviated) Day}.*
