1. Anchors Pins;
2. Any instrument set (including loaners) that may contain any potential non- biological implantable device(s);
3. Bolts;
4. Breast implants;
5. Cranial implants;
6. Heart valves;
7. Internal pacemakers or Implantable Cardiac Defibrillator (ICD);
8. Joints (such as knees, hips, and shoulders);
9. Marlex mesh;
10. Mersilene mesh;
11. Nails;
12. Nuts;
13. Penile implants;
14. Plates;
15. Rods;
16. Screws;
17. Stents;
18. Vascular grafts; and
19. Washers
