David Johnson was appointed as the Assistant Inspector General for Investigations in May 2019. In this capacity, Mr. Johnson oversees the Office of Investigations and directs criminal and civil investigations involving fraud, waste, and abuse in the VA's programs and operations nationwide. He is responsible for managing the headquarters office, seven regional field offices, and over 30 resident agency offices comprised of more than 200 special agents and other specialized staff.

Mr. Johnson previously served for over a decade as a federal prosecutor. He was an Assistant Chief in the Fraud Section of the Department of Justice's Criminal Division, as well as an Assistant United States Attorney and Health Care Fraud Coordinator at the United States Attorney's Office for the District of Columbia. Mr. Johnson also served as an Assistant Chief Litigation Counsel at the Securities and Exchange Commission. He began his career as an associate at an international law firm and a law clerk for the Honorable Rosemary M. Collyer on the United States District Court for the District of Columbia.

Mr. Johnson received his B.A. in Government from the University of Virginia and J.D. from William & Mary School of Law. He previously served as an adjunct law professor at Georgetown University Law Center.
