Mr. Snyder has served as the Principal Deputy Assistant Secretary for Policy and Planning since September 2010. In this role he acts as OPP's senior career executive as well as the organization's Chief Operating Officer. Mr. Snyder previously served VA as the Executive Director of VA's Office of VA/DoD Collaboration, and most recently as Acting Assistant Secretary for Policy and Planning from January 2013 to October 2014.

During a 26-year Army career, Mr. Snyder served in various operational assignments as a Field Artillery Officer. From 1989 until 1993, he was assigned to the faculty of the Department of Social Sciences at West Point. Additionally, he served in multiple staff assignments including as a Strategist in the Office of the Army Chief of Staff and as the Senior Military Advisor to the Director for Operational Test and Evaluation within the Office of the Secretary of Defense. After his 2007 retirement from the Army, he joined the team of Accenture Management Consulting as a Senior Consultant.

Mr. Snyder is from Ravenswood, West Virginia and is a 1981 graduate of the United States Military Academy at West Point. He obtained a Master's Degree in Political Science from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology and a Master's Degree in Strategic Policy from the National War College.
