Mr. John P. Medve has served as the Acting Assistant Secretary for the Office of Enterprise Integration (OEI) since January 20, 2021. In this role, he continues to focus on enhancing Veteran and employee experiences through effective enterprise integration with an emphasis on people, processes, technology, innovations, and management capabilities. Mr. Medve leads Departmental efforts in strategic planning, enterprise risk management, performance management, policy management and analysis, transformation and innovations, data analytics and statistics, data governance, and interagency coordination and collaboration.

Mr. Medve was appointed to the Senior Executive Service in September 2010 and has most recently served as the Executive Director for the Office of Policy and Interagency Collaboration. His responsibilities have included leading the VA enterprise directive management system, VA organizational change process and Department of Veterans Affairs/Department of Defense collaboration.

Mr. Medve served for 24 years in the United States Army. He was commissioned in December 1978 from the Reserve Officer Training Corps as a Distinguished Military Graduate. His major assignments included Commander, 2d Squadron, 16th Cavalry Regiment; Chief, Long-Range Planning Team in Army G-3; Executive Officer, 1st Brigade, 3rd Infantry Division; Executive Officer, 3-69 Armor; Deputy G-3, 2d Infantry Division, Assistant Professor of American Politics in the Department of Social Sciences, United States Military Academy; and Commander, Headquarter and Headquarters Company, 3-67 Armor, Troop Commander, Fox Troop, 2d Squadron, 2d Armored Cavalry Regiment.

His military awards include the Legion of Merit, Meritorious Service Medal and Army Commendation Medal.
