

Change in Business Structure Fact Sheet

Summary:

Does a company's change in business structure affect its Dun & Bradstreet D-U-N-S[®] Number and its VetBiz Vendor Information Pages (VIP) profile?

Discussion:

Whether a business must change its D-U-N-S Number when it changes its business structure is determined by Dun & Bradstreet. If a company has an additional D-U-N-S Number and would like to change the D-U-N-S Number in its VIP profile, the company will need to **create a** *new* **profile** for the new D-U-N-S Number by reapplying for verification in accordance with <u>38 CFR §</u> <u>74.11</u>.

To report any business changes, the company will need to submit a change request from the VetBiz VIP profile. For assistance with submitting a change request, please contact the Center for Verification and Evaluation (CVE).

CVE will process the change request. To ensure the change request is completed in a timely fashion, it is important for the company to provide accurate and up-todate documentation as it pertains to the business structure change.

CVE may require additional documentation to complete the processing of the change request. *Note:* All changes must be consistent with the eligibility requirement
