**MEMORANDUM FOR THE ASSISTANT SECRETARY FOR HUMAN RESOURCES
AND ADMINISTRATION/OPERATIONS, SECURITY, AND PREPAREDNESS**

SUBJECT: Delegation of Authority to Approve or Disapprove Collective Bargaining Agreements or Amendments that are not Subject to a Controlling Higher-Level Agreement

- 1. DELEGATION.** This memorandum delegates to the Assistant Secretary for Human Resources and Administration/Operations, Security, and Preparedness, after appropriate consultation with officials in the Administrations and the Office of General Counsel, the authority to approve or disapprove, in accordance with 5 United States Code (U.S.C.) § 7114(c), collective bargaining agreements or amendments that are not subject to a controlling higher-level agreement.
- 2. AUTHORITY.** 38 U.S.C. §§ 303, 512.
- 3. RESTRICTIONS.** None.
- 4. REDELEGATION.** The Assistant Secretary for Human Resources and Administration/Operations, Security, and Preparedness may further redelegate this authority to the Chief Human Capital Officer and/or the Executive Director for Labor-Management Relations.
- 5. RESCISSION.** Delegation of Authority to Approve or Disapprove Collective Bargaining Agreements, March 21, 2008.
- 6. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This delegation of authority is effective upon signature. I waive the 2-year expiration date required by VA Directive 0000, Delegations of Authority, and this delegation is effective for 4 years from the date of signature.
