SUBJECT: Designation of Voting Member and Liaison on the Architectural and
Transportation Barriers Compliance Board (Access Board) (VIEWS 9526483).

1. DESIGNATION. This memorandum designates the Executive Director, Office of Construction and Facilities Management as the voting member and liaison of the Architectural and Transportation Barriers Compliance Board, referred to as the United States Access Board, for the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA).
