

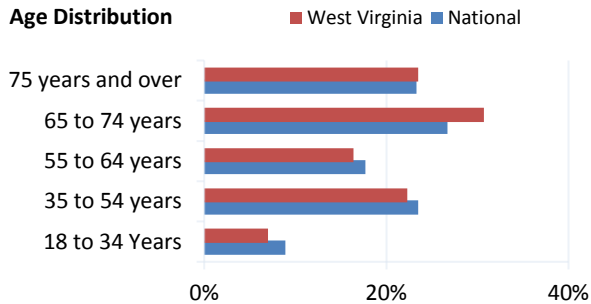

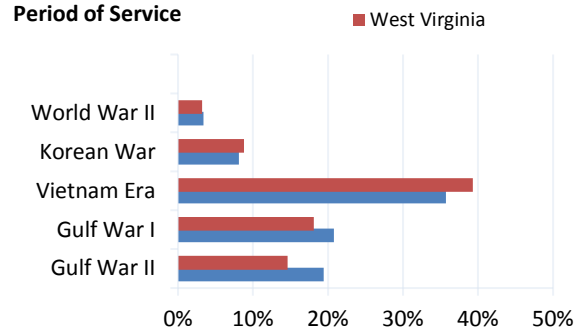

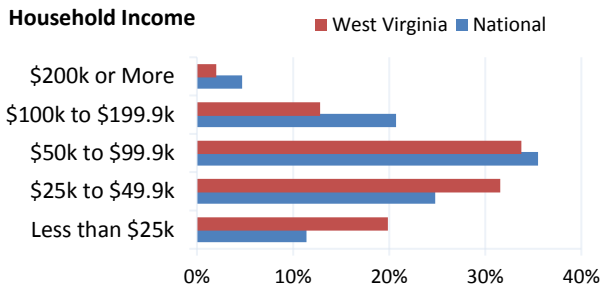
Age Distribution



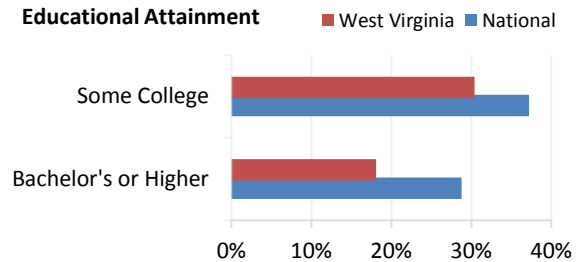
Period of Service
